HOW TO MODEL AND MAP CATCHMENT PROCESSES WHEN FLOOD RISK MANAGEMENT PLANNING

The Environment Agency have reviewed existing flood risk management modelling software, mapping techniques and data to help practitioners select the best tools when developing WwNP projects to reduce flood risk.

Outputs:

- **Library of tools** to select tools, data and models to use in a catchment.
- **Detailed report** summarising models, tools, data and their pros and cons.
- **20 case studies** to show how different models have been used across the UK.
