What is the Sustainable Eel Standard?

ล Like MSC, but for Eel



- Series of tests, based on MSC principles, to see if those in the supply chain are operating sustainably. Components for:
- ล Independent assessor
- Institute of Fisheries Management
- Kings College, London
- Zoological Society of London
- ICES
- 2 x France fisheries scientists
- Fishmongers Hall

- Commitment to sustainability, legality
- Traceability
- Glass eel fisheries
- Yellow and silver eel fisheries
- Collecting, buying & handling
- Eel farming
- Restocking
- Smokeries, Processors, Retailers



Why do we need the Standard?

- ล Help and demonstrate transformation of the commercial sector towards sustainability
- Requires high standards through the supply chain:
 fishermen → buyers → farms → smokeries → retailer →
 consumer
- ล Supports <u>EC Eel Regulation</u>: 60% of glass eels caught for restocking, 40% for consumption. 'Sustainable use of the stock'
- ล Part of the solution for sustainable management of the Eel in Europe
- ล Confidence to consumers who wish to buy responsibly

Objectives

Aim of the Standard (from 'Theory of Change')

to maximise the contribution of eel fishers, ranchers, aquaculturalists, traders and consumers of eel products to the restoration of healthy eel populations, distributed throughout their natural range, fulfilling their role in the aquatic environment and supporting sustainable use for the benefit of communities, local economies and traditions.

Supporting objectives

- The Standard will be designed to ensure that implementation of the SEG Standard at the level of each individual SEG certificate holder has a <u>net benefit</u> on eel populations
- necessary to monitor the efficacy of the Standard in achieving its objectives.
