Possible Agenda Topics

1. Setting up the Body (1100 to 1230)

- How is the eel body to be managed, resourced and or funded?

- Updates on the Eel Recovery Plans from the EA. Have these been approved?
- Update to the progress on Bye Laws and the public response from EA (Heidi/Miran).
- Update on the Eel Working Group and CITES from Robert Rosell.
- Update on the coming fishing season from Peter Wood
- What is happening in Europe and what other European bodies are emerging to promote the eel, like the Future for Eel?

• The EFF and the offer of Steve Bailey to come to our next meeting with the head of their grants unit to explain how it works and how the Eel might benefit.
