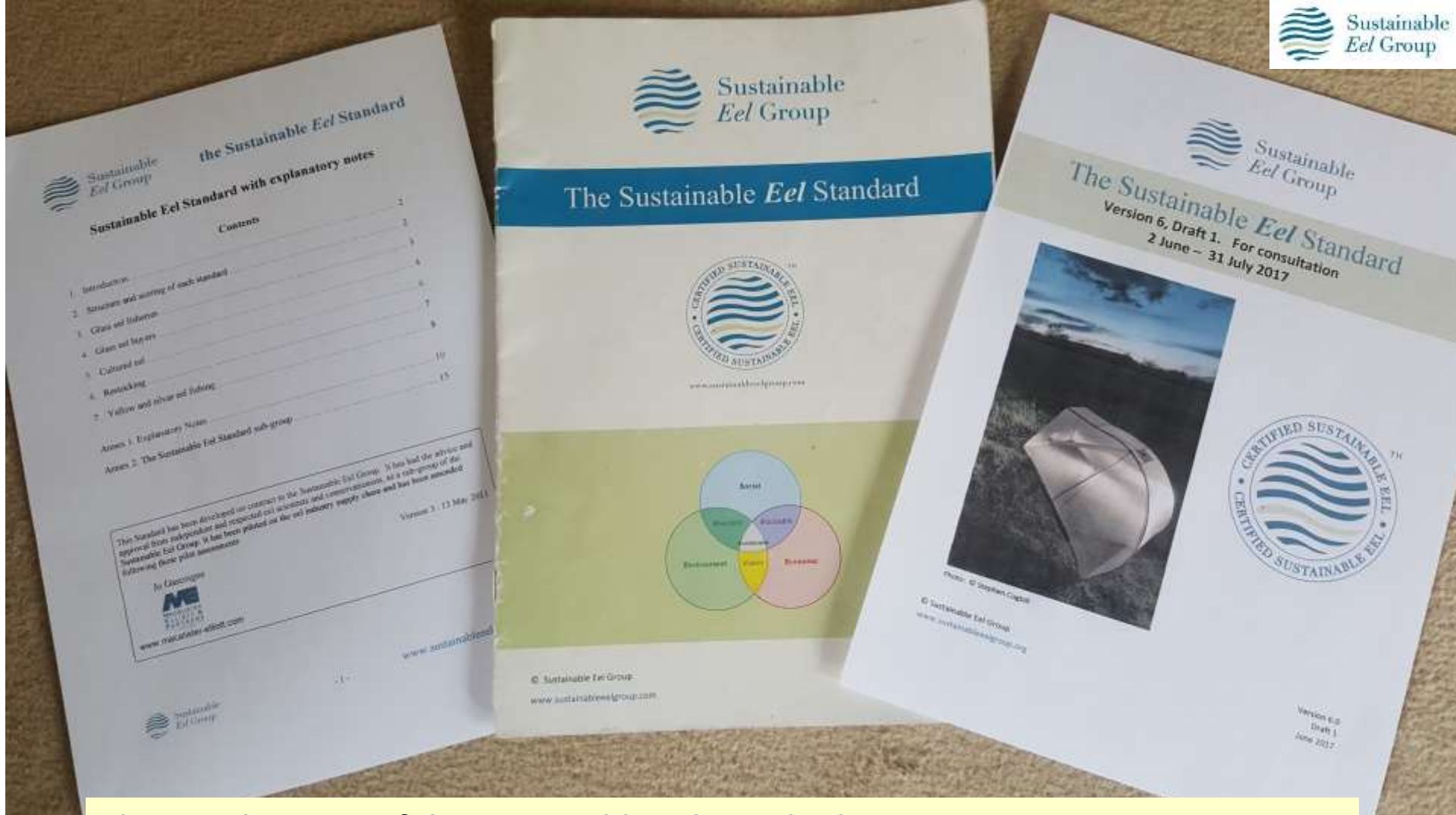

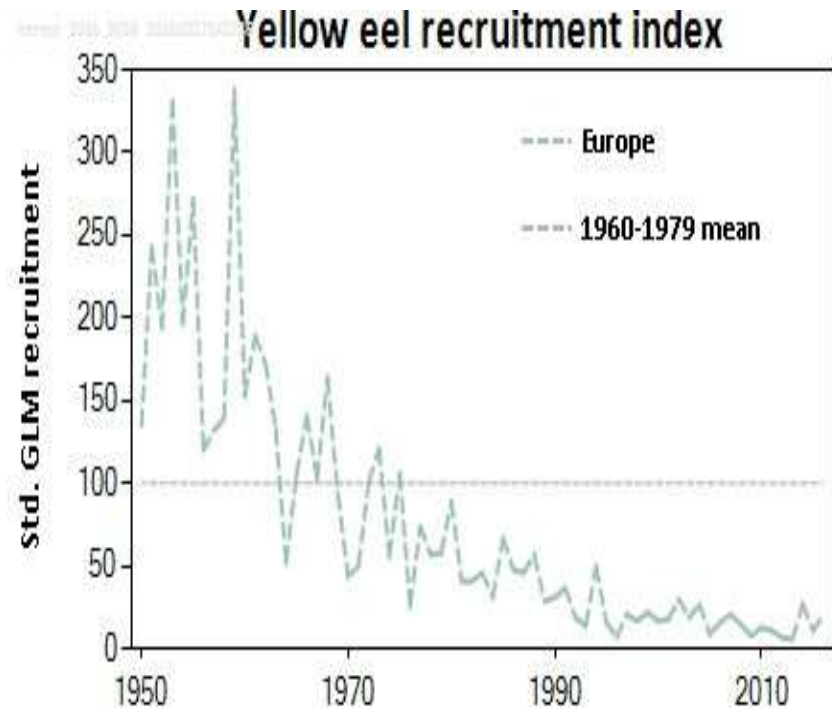
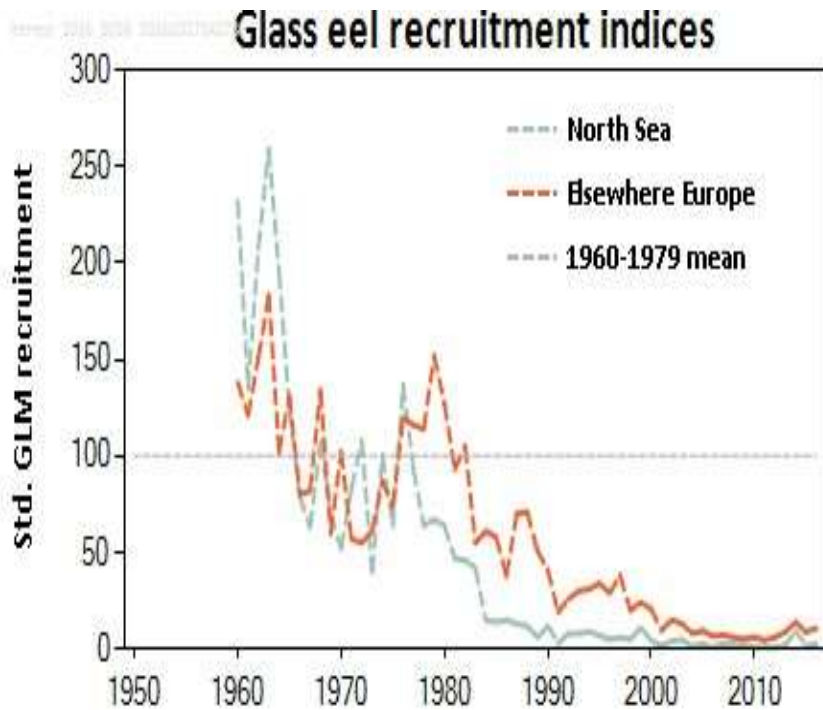


HFW on EEL
