

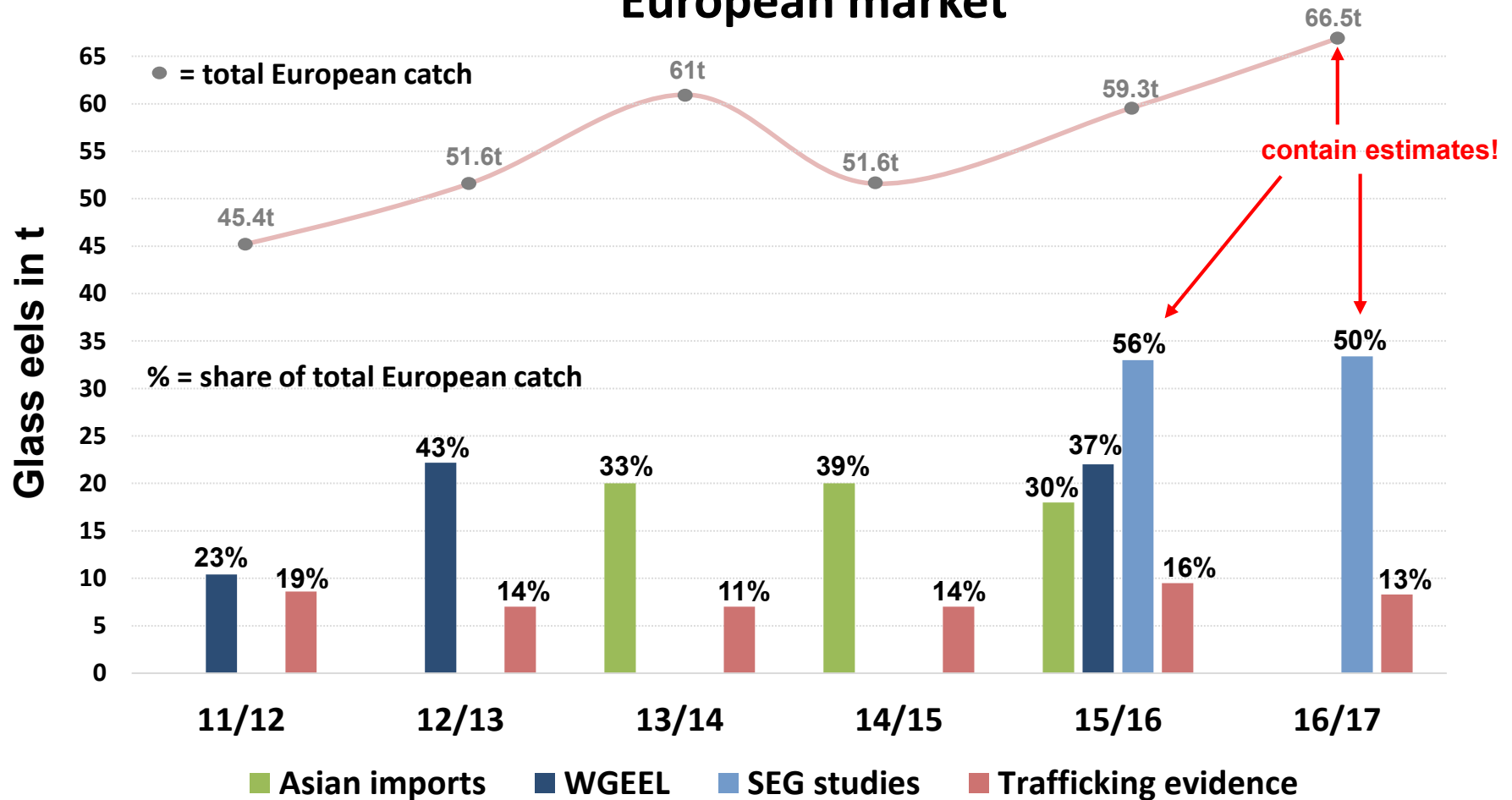

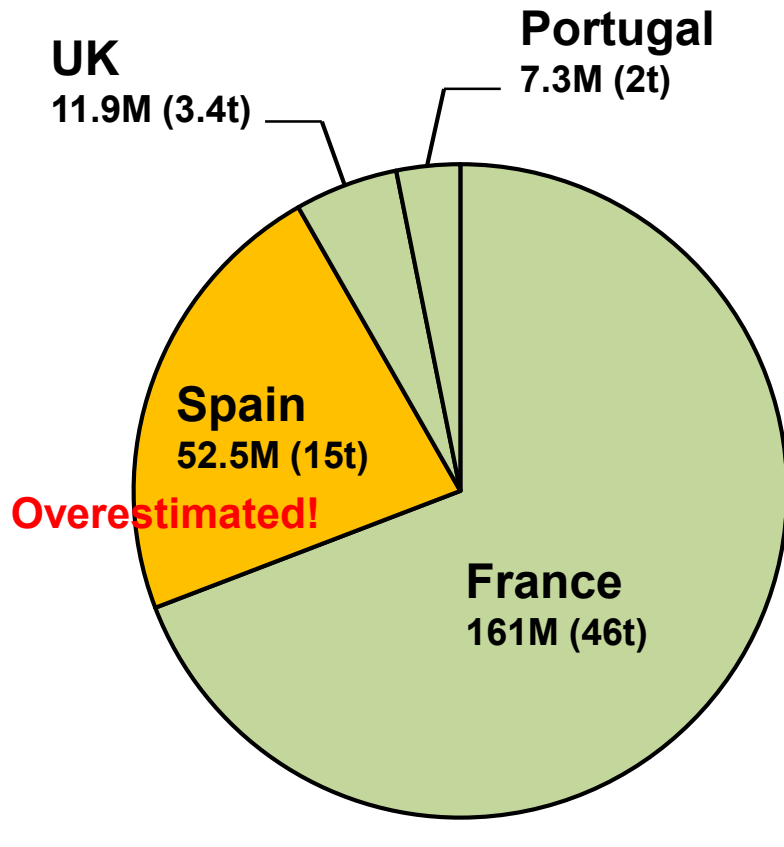

individual weight = 0.28g



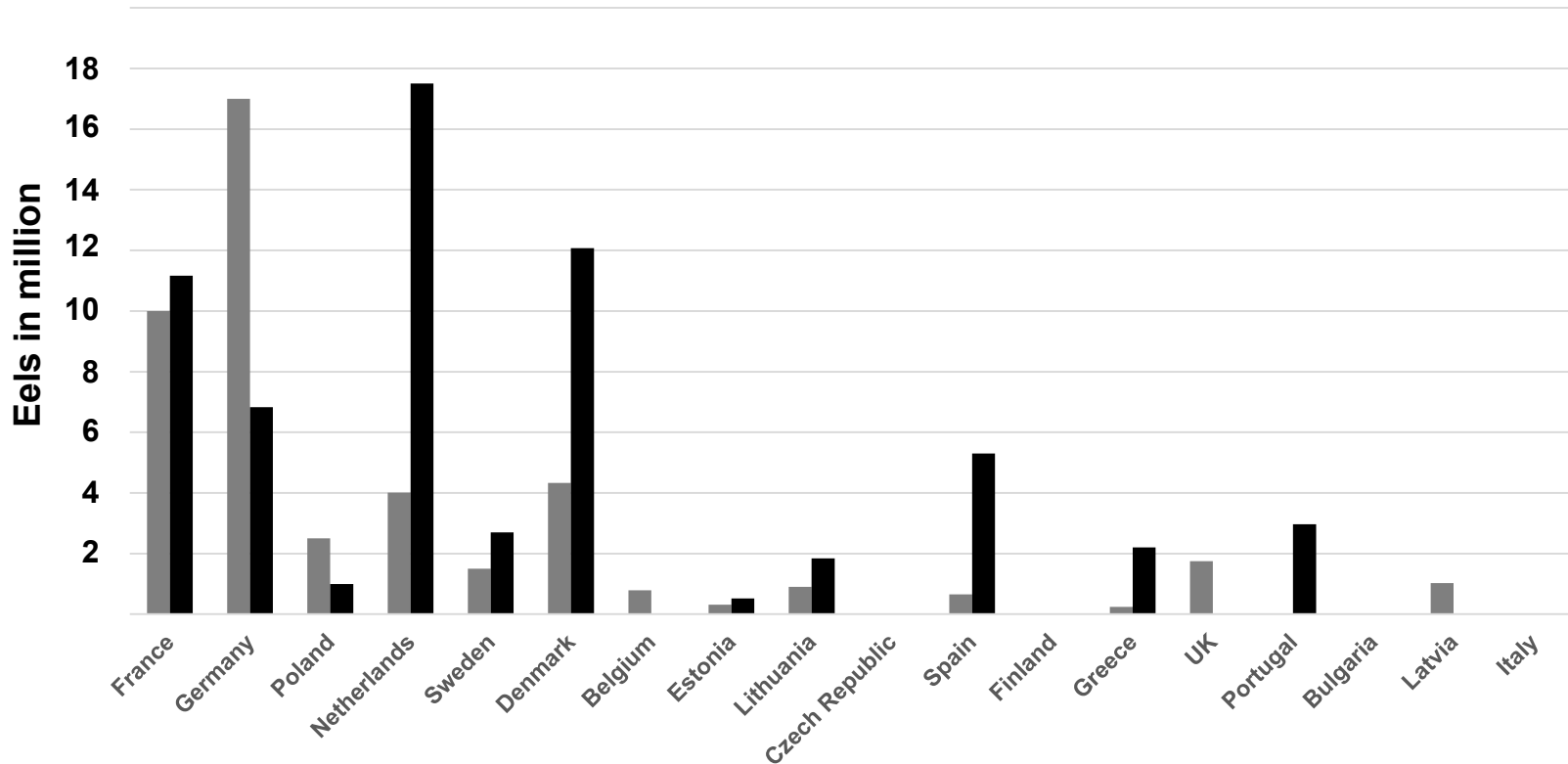

European glass eel demand by country (2016/2017)



- **Restocking** contains data about conducted and planned restockings and eels that were traded for restocking
- **Farming/Consumption** contains eels for direct consumption, reported by farmers and authorities



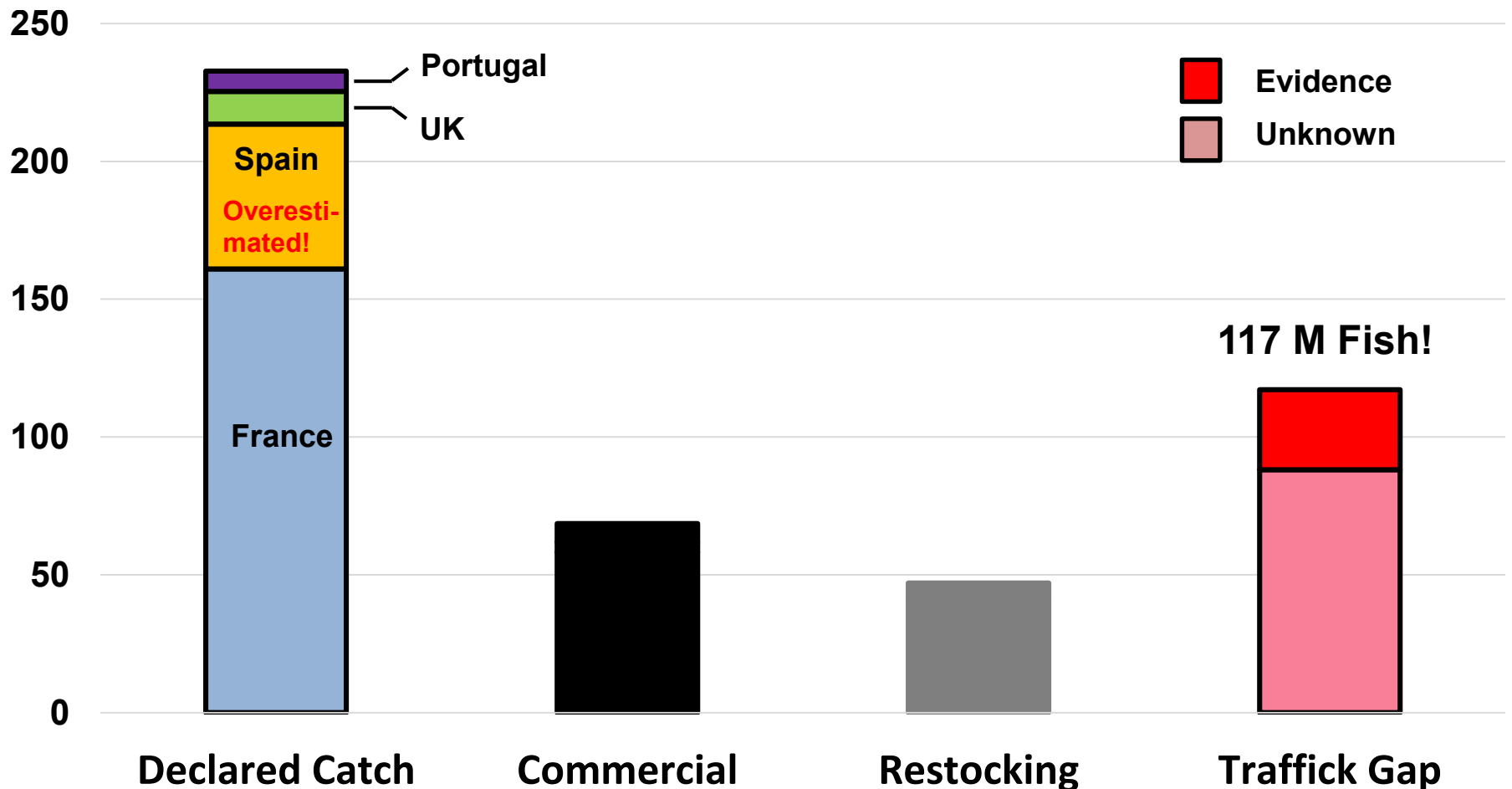

European glass eel demand by purpose (2016/2017)





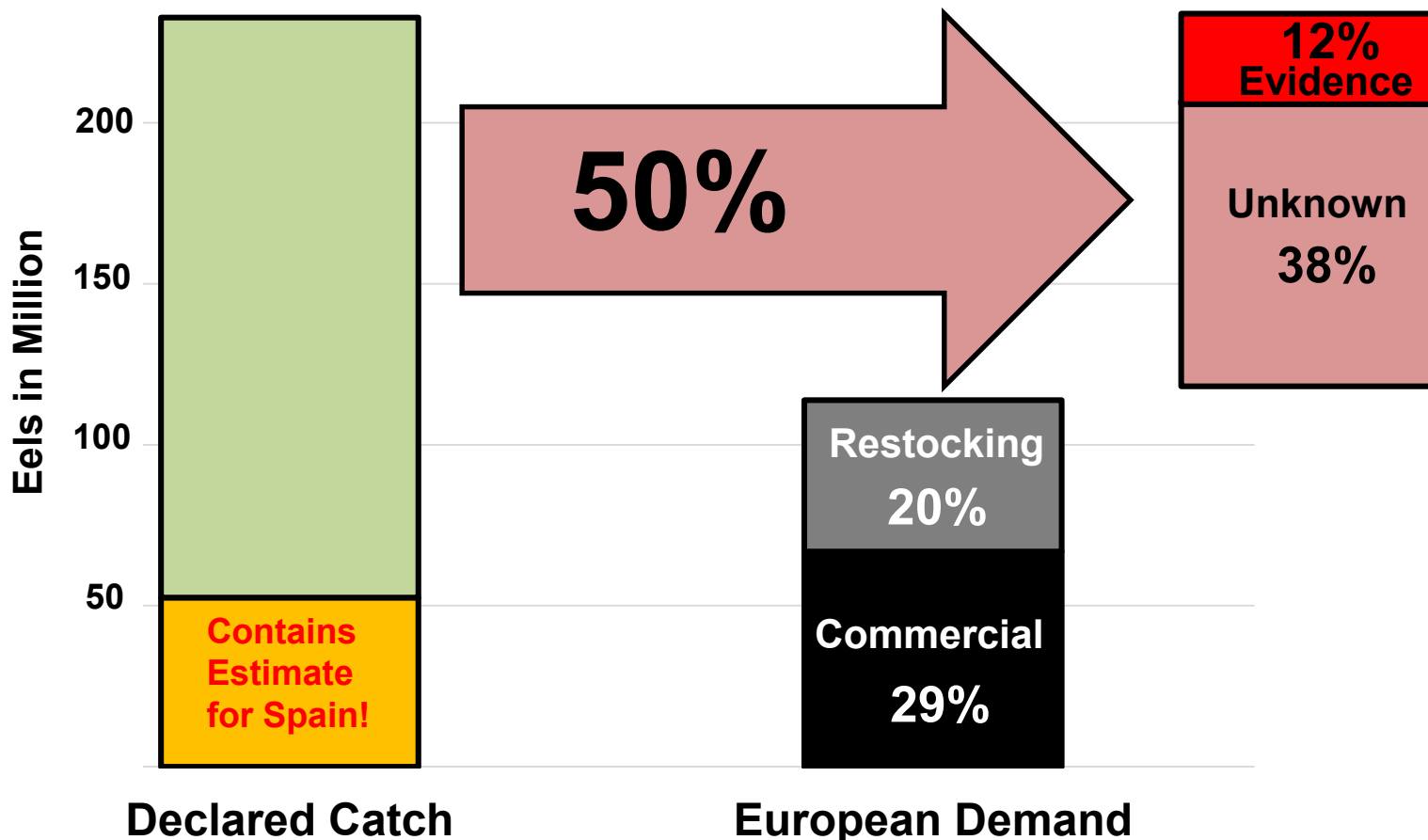
